



## **Board Committee Volunteer Opportunities**

### **Development Committee**

The Development Committee is responsible for identifying means of raising revenue to support the fundraising efforts of School on Wheels. The Development Committee assists with the implementation of fundraising strategies on an annual basis. The Development Committee guides and supports the various giving campaigns and special events. This committee also ensures that the fundraising and marketing goals set forth in the strategic plan are met. This committee is comprised of both Board and non-Board members. Commitment: 2-3 hours/month

### **IDEA (Inclusion, Diversity, Equity, and Awareness) Committee**

The IDEA Committee is a group of volunteers dedicated to broadening volunteers, staff, and board to be more representative of the children, families, and community in which we work and serve. This committee assists the organization in developing and implementing changes that ensure that School on Wheels becomes the most diverse, equitable, and inclusive organization possible. This committee is comprised of both Board and non-Board members. Commitment: 2-3 hours/month

### **Event Committee**

The Event Committee works alongside staff on logistics for special events like the annual Education Celebration that raise funds and boost awareness for the organization. This group helps with planning, auction item solicitation, event set-up/close out, and by introducing new people to the organization through event attendance. This committee is comprised of both Board and non-Board members. Commitment: 2-3 hours/month, December – April

### **SPOKES Committee**

SPOKES is School on Wheels' community outreach group for young professionals. Committee members work to engage and educate the community about youth homelessness and all of the challenges that youth face while striving for educational success. Members also help support School on Wheels' unmet needs by recruiting volunteers, supporting and hosting events, hosting supply drives, participating in fundraising, and serving as community advocates. SPOKES members will also work to engage and educate younger generations to encourage involvement and support. Commitment: 2-3 hours/month
